Getting Convascf Program to stay on screen in XP

When running Convascf in XP, there is a tendency for the program to run and the screen to close quickly when complete. This causes confusion, as it appears the program did not run correctly, when indeed it has.

One way to keep the DOS box on the screen when running Convascf is to create a desktop shortcut to the command prompt and exit after running the Convascf program.

First, right click the Start button. Choose Search. Search for "CMD.EXE" in the C: directory of the PC you are running Convascf on.

Highlight the filename "CMD.EXE" with a right mouse click and select create shortcut. Send the shortcut to the desktop.

Click the Shortcut to CMD.EXE icon.

At the prompt C:\Windows\System32> , enter the path where the Convascf resides. For example, C:\STI.

At the C:\STI> prompt, type "Convascf".

Run the Convascf program

At the completion of the Convascf program, you are returned to the C:\STI> prompt (in our example).

Type "Exit" to return to XP.
